Housed in a tractor trailer, the exhibit pays tribute to the men and women who served in World War I. Developed in partnership with the National World War I Museum of Kansas City, Mo., ***Honoring Our History*** exposes the sights, sounds and personal experiences of the Great War.

At 6 pm, visitors are welcome to attend a special reception for the exhibit in The State Museum's Memorial Hall hosted by Waddell & Reed, sponsors of the traveling exhibit. The event and the reception are free and open to the public.
