STATE MUSEUM CALLS FOR ENTRIES FOR CRAFT EXHIBIT

HARRISBURG – Craftsmen from throughout the commonwealth have the chance to see how their work stacks up to the competition as The State Museum of Pennsylvania calls for entries for its first juried craft exhibit later this year.

The Nov. 18 – March 19 contest, which will unfold in the state museum, is open to state craftsmen working in wood, ceramics, fiber, metal, paper and other media.

Harrisburg Area Community College and the Pennsylvania Guild of Craftsmen, with support from the Pennsylvania Department of Community and Economic Development, partnered to present this judged event.

“This is a great opportunity for Pennsylvania craftsmen to show off their skills to a wide audience,” said Pennsylvania Historical and Museum Commission Executive Director Barbara Franco.

Participants will be eligible for cash prizes and the opportunity to sell their work at the state museum. The deadline for applications, which are available at www.pacrafts.com/exhibit, is June 30.

Robert Pfannebecker and Sylvia Lehman, both prominent in the field of crafts, will serve as jurors.
