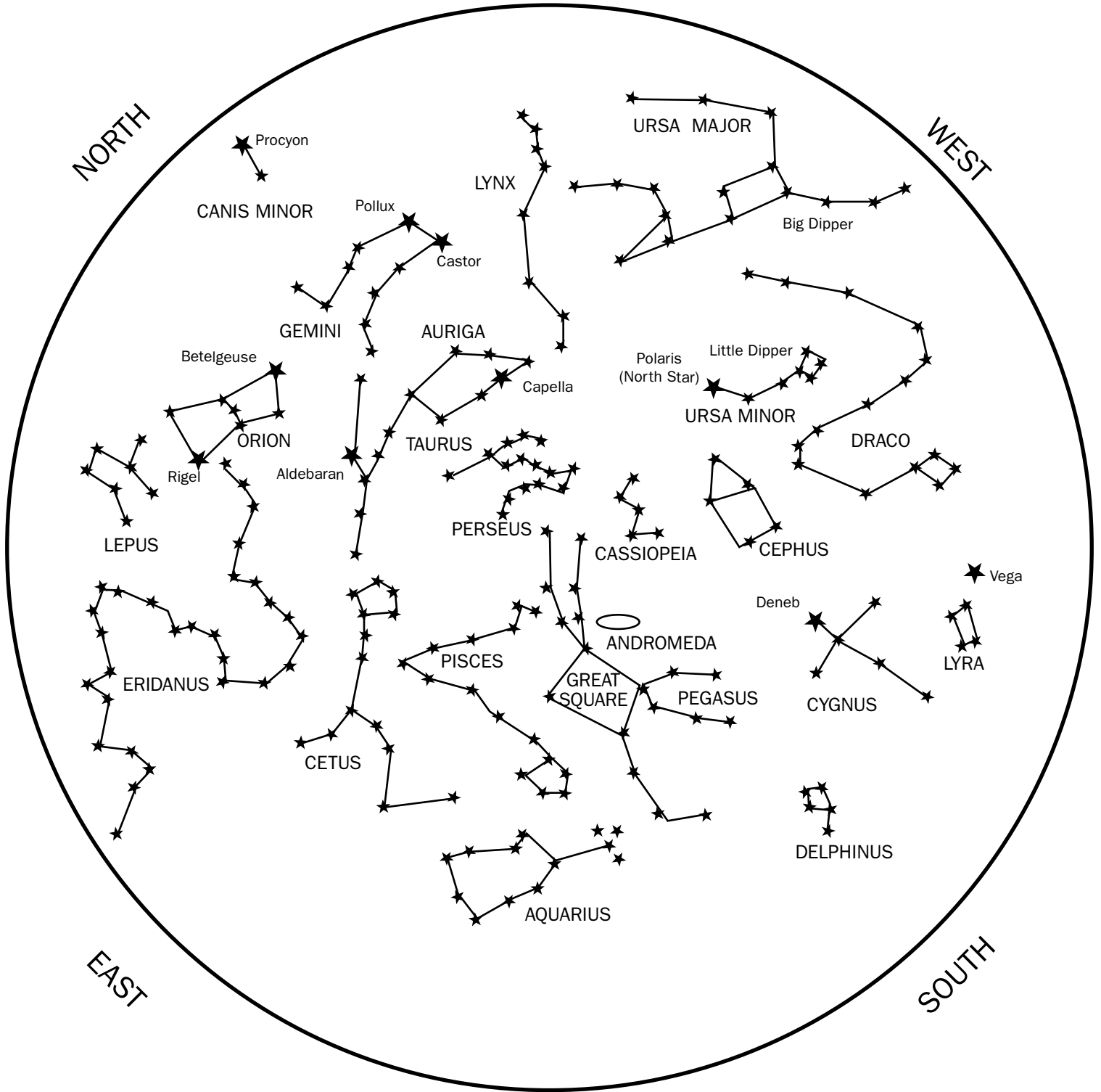


The Evening Sky for the Month of December

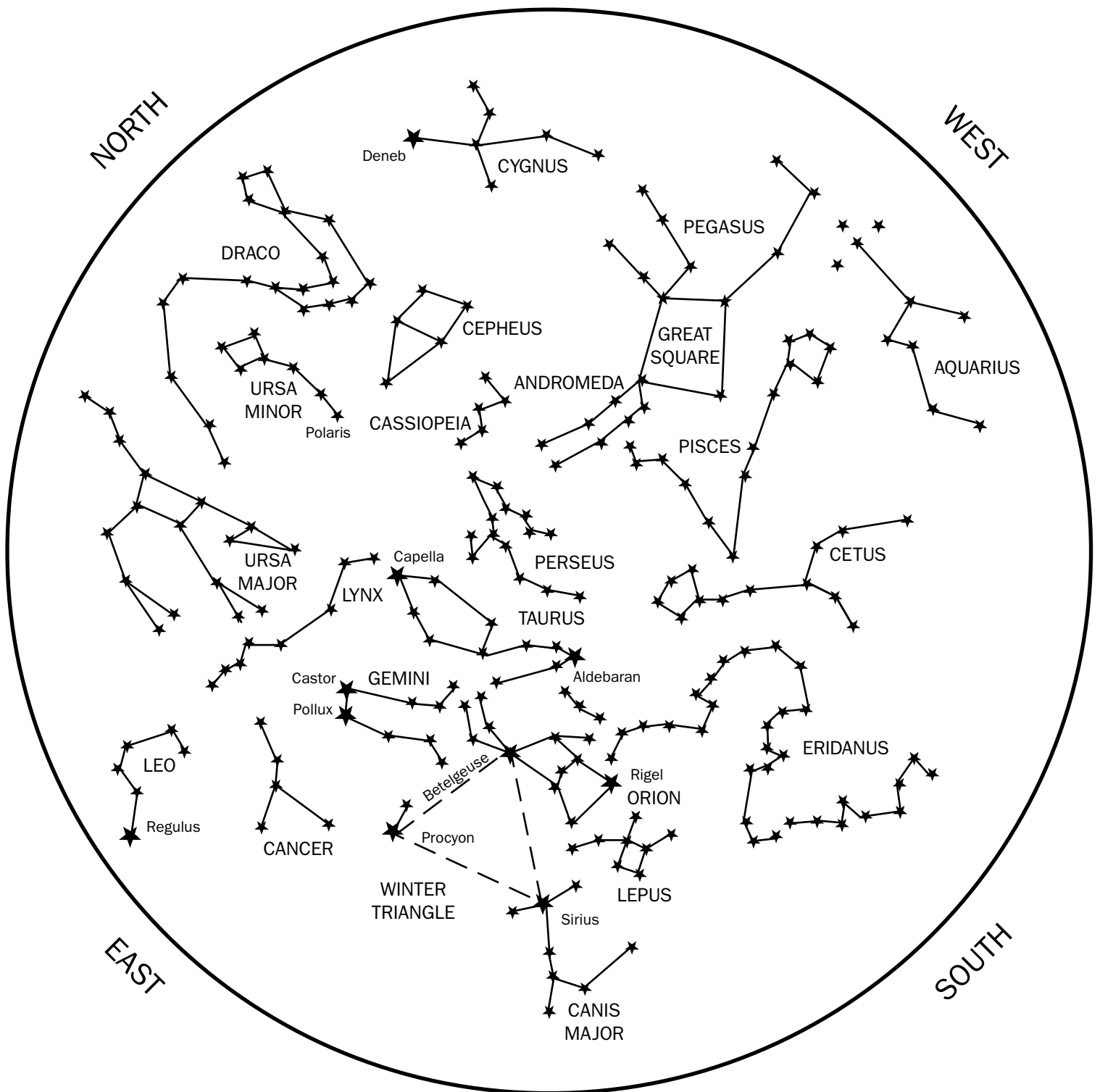

The Evening Sky for the Month of January

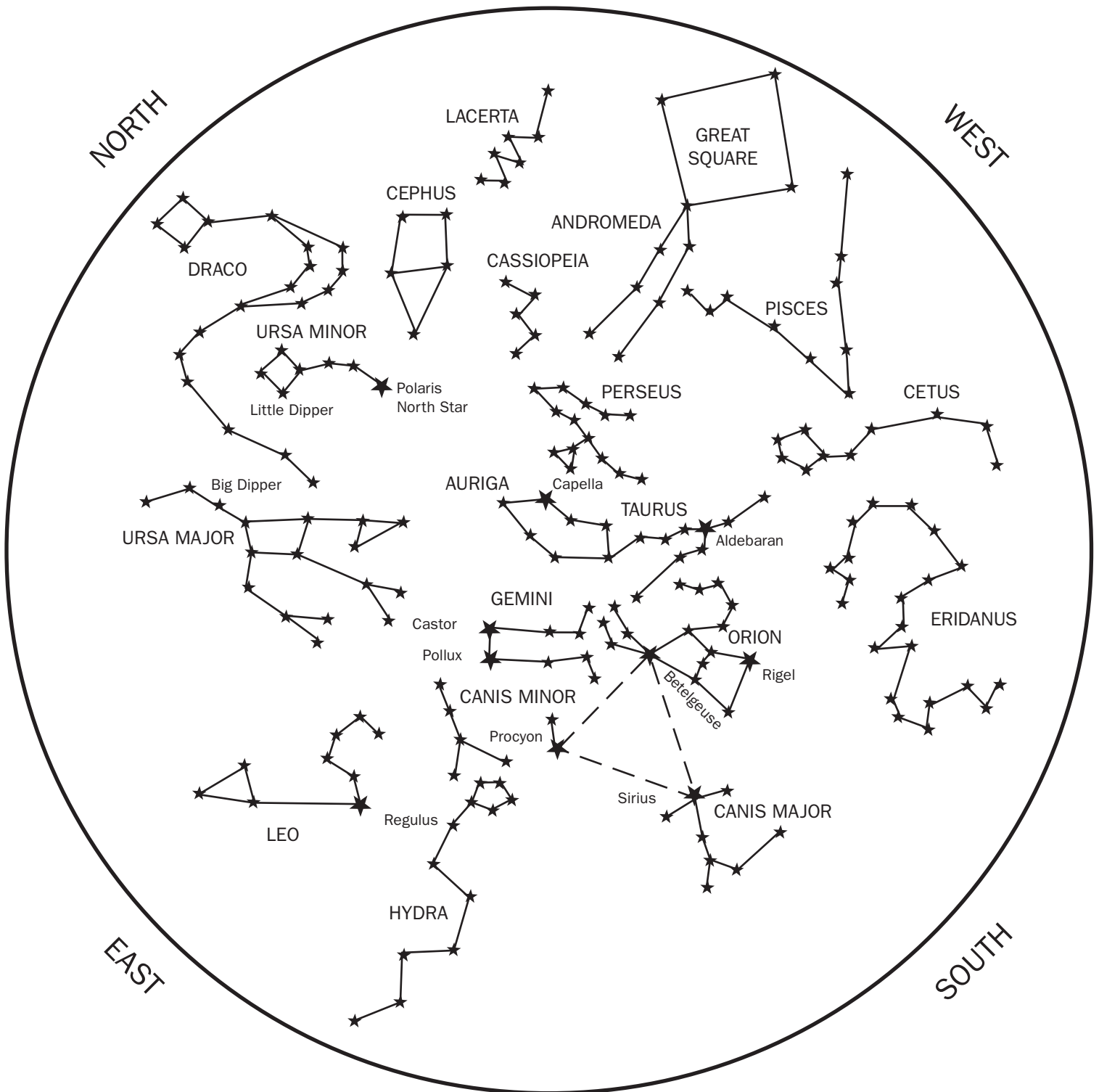
